To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Joseph Bailey of St. Josephs County Indiana  
 hath deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Crawfordsville  
 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph Bailey  
 according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands;" for  
 the South East quarter of Section Twenty seven, in Township Thirty seven North, of Range Six West, in  
 the District of lands subject to sale at Crawfordsville Indiana containing One hundred & fifty nine acres  
 & Eighty hundredths of an acre  
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
 chased by the said Joseph Bailey  
 NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several  
 acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Joseph Bailey  
 and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To  
 Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Joseph  
 Bailey and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Andrew Jackson  
 PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto  
 affixed.
