whereas, Ephraim Seely and John Reynolds of Elkhart County Indiana
have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Wayne,

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Ephraim Seely and John Reynolds,
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the North East quarter of section Nine, in Township thirty six, of Range Six,
in the District of Lanes subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana; Containing
One Hundred and六十 Acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Ephraim Seely and John Reynolds.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Ephraim Seely
and John Reynolds
and to their heirs, the said tract above described. To
Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Ephraim
Seely and John Reynolds
and to their heirs and assigns forever.
as lessees in common (and not as joint tenants).
