To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Isaac Snider, of Union County, Indiana,
 had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte,
 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Isaac Snider,
 according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
 the North West quarter of Section Thirty, in Township thirty seven North, of Range five, West of the Second
 Meridian, in the District of lands subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana; containing one hundred and sixty
 acres, and thirty tens hundreds of an acre,
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
 chased by the said Isaac Snider.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
 several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Isaac
 Snider
 and to his heirs the said tract above described:
 To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said
 Isaac Snider
 and to his heirs and assigns forever.
