To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Jacob Bigelow, Joshua Hobart, Joshua Peache Warren Cole and Robert Stewart of the State of Indiana, having deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jacob Bigelow, Joshua Hobart, Joshua Peache Warren Cole and Robert Stewart according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 25th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the West half of the North East quarter of Section Sixteen, in Township Thirty Seven North, of Range Six, West of the Second Meridian, in the District of Indiana subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing Twenty five acres and Seventy Nine Fourtenths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jacob Bigelow, Joshua Hobart, Joshua Peache Warren Cole and Robert Stewart.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jacob Bigelow, Joshua Hobart, Joshua Peache Warren Cole and Robert Stewart and to their heirs the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Jacob Bigelow, Joshua Hobart, Joshua Peache Warren Cole and Robert Stewart and to their heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common and not as joint tenants.
