To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Landon Rose Cabell of Campbell County, Virginia,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Landon Rose Cabell
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the West half of the North West quarter of Section eighteen, in Township thirty-four, North of Range five West of the second
Meridian, in the District of Land, subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing eighty-one acres, and fifteen hun-
dredths of an acre,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Landon Rose Cabell.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Landon
Rose Cabell

and to his heirs the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said
Landon Rose Cabell

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
