Whereas John Beal Steenbergen and George W. Allen, Assignees of William Clark
have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Clark
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the West half of the North West quarter of section seven, in Township Thirty Six, North of Range five West, in the
District of lands subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing seventy two acres, and ninety seven hundredths
of an acre,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said William Clark

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Beal
Steenbergen and George W. Allen and to their heirs the said tract above described:
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said
John Beal Steenbergen, and George W. Allen, and to their heirs and assigns forever.
as tenant, in common and not as joint tenants.
