To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Harvey Edward Woodruff of La Porte County, Indiana
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Harvey Edward Woodruff
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the North East quarter of Section Thirty-four, in Township Thirty-Six, North of Range five West, in the District of
Landy, subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing one hundred and sixty acres,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Harvey Edward Woodruff.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Harvey
Edward Woodruff, and to his heirs the said tract above described.
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said
Harvey Edward Woodruff, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, has caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed.
