 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edmund D. Wolff
 according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d^d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
 the North half of the North West quarter of Section six in Township thirty-five North Range
 west in the district of lands subject to sale at La Porte Indiana Containing seventy-one
 and nineteen hundredths of an acre
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
 chased by the said Edmund D. Wolff

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
 several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edmund
 D. Wolff and to his heirs, the said tract above described:
 To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said
 Edmund D. Wolff and to his heirs and assigns forever.
