Whereas William Gassett, Assignee of William Nicholas Switzer, of LaPorte County, Indiana,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at LaPorte.—
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Nicholas Switzer,
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the east half of the North West quarter of Section twenty eight, in Township thirty six North, of
Range Six West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at LaPorte, Indiana containing
Eighty acres.
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur=chased by the said William Nicholas Switzer.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said William Gassett
and to his heirs, the said tract above described:
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said
William Gassett and to his heirs and assigns forever.
