 Six West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Laporte Indiana, containing Eighty Acres.

 To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said

 and to his heirs and assigns forever.
