# The United States of America,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas William Royster of Marion County Indiana  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Laporte  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Royster  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
the East half of the South West quarter, of Section thirty six, in Township thirty six North, of Range  
six West, in the District of Landes subject to sale at Laporte Indiana containing Eighty  
Acres,  
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
chased by the said William Royster

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said William Royster  
and to his heirs, the said tract above described.  
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said  
William Royster and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *John Quincy Adams*,  
PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto  
affixed.

Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two, and of the Independence of the United States  
the Sixty first.
