# The United States of America.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Caleb Strong Fiske, and Lemuel Fiske, of Laporte County, Indiana have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Laporte, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Caleb Strong Fiske, and Lemuel Fiske according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the West half of the North West quarter, of Section twenty two, in Township thirty seven, North, of Range five West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Laporte Indiana, containing Eighty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Caleb Strong Fiske and Lemuel Fiske

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Caleb Strong Fiske, and Lemuel Fiske and to their heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Caleb Strong Fiske and Lemuel Fiske and to their heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common and not as joint tenants,

In testimony whereof, I, Martin Van Buren  
PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
