according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the Lots Numbered three and four, of Section thirty, three, in Township thirty, seven north, of Range five
West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Laporte, Indiana, Containing One hundred
and eighteen Acres, and sixteen hundredths of an Acre,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Jacob Hoar

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jeremiah
Atkins and to his heirs, the said tract above described:
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said
Jeremiah Atkins and to his heirs and assigns forever.
