To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 22d, 1852, entitled "An Act to make Bounty Land Warrants assignable, and for other purposes," Warrant No. *469* for *80* acres, issued in favor of *John Hedderson Private in Captain Wallace's Company Texas Volunteers Indian War*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *East half of the South west quarter of Section eighteen in Township thirty three of Range five west, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Winamac Indiana, at the time of Location, containing eighty Acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *which has been asigned to Mark & Reeves*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Mark & Reeves*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Mark & Reeves, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *Franklin Pierce* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
