Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850,

entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 55,178 for 40 acres,

issued in favor of *Theron Holmes, Sergeant, Captain Bennett's Company, 6th Missouri Military, War 1812,*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the

South East quarter of the North East quarter, of Section eighteen, in Township thirty five, of Range six, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Winamac, Indiana, containing forty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Theron Holmes,

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Theron Holmes, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
