according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *Quarter quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John Dimwiddie and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
