To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Samuel N. Merrill, Sergeant, in Captain Robinson's Company, Third Regiment Ohio Foot, Volunteers,

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *his* favor numbered *B, L 5 P.*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Charles E. Phay, as signed of Elom Phay, assignee of Charles B. Stickney and Henry Brown, who were assignees of said Samuel N. Merrill, and to his heirs, the West half of the South West quarter, and the West half of the North West quarter, of Section Thirty Two, in Township Thirty Five, North, of Range Six, West, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Winamac, Indiana, containing one Hundred and Sixty acres.*

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *half quarters* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Charles E. Phay, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
