Know Ye, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847.

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in his favor, numbered

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *James I Brody,*  
*assignee of the estate of John McLean, and to  
his heirs, the North West quarter of section  
two, in Township thirty three, of Range  
six, west, in the District of Lands subject  
to sale at Vevianoe, Indiana, containing  
one hundred and fifty seven acres, and  
sixty hundredths of an acre.*


